

# Call for Papers

Authors who presented at the 2011 conference of the Jungian Society for Scholarly Studies, held at Cornell University, August 2-7, 2011, are invited to submit a paper to Volume 7 of *Journal of Jungian Scholarly Studies* or Volume 2 of *Conversations in the Field*. Work presented at earlier JSSS conferences is also eligible. ## ***Journal of Jungian Scholarly Studies***

*Journal of Jungian Scholarly Studies* is a peer reviewed, academic journal. It is not a publication of conference papers. The intent is that papers presented at the conference will be revised and developed to make them suitable for publication in a scholarly journal. For instance, papers should include a theoretical framework or literature review that situates the piece in the midst of existing academic dialogue by extending or critiquing (or filling gaps in) that dialogue. For instance, in fields other than Jungian Studies, what does a Jungian orientation bring to the field that other perspectives do not? Such material may be covered in conventional or creative ways.

Papers will be reviewed initially by the editor, and then at the editor's discretion will undergo the blind review process, in which the work will be read by at least two referees who are not informed of the author's identity. The editor will analyze the feedback from the referees, and the article will then receive one of the following designations: "Accepted", "Revisions Requested", or "Not Accepted for Publication." The editor may also choose to invite the author to publish the article in *Conversations in the Field* as described below.

Submissions should include an abstract of 100 words. The abstract should include the title and identity of the author. The paper should have no indication of the author's identity. Papers should clearly and thoroughly follow either MLA or APA format. There is no minimum or maximum length. The journal is able to publish images, video, or audio.

The deadline for submission is October 31, 2011.

## ***Conversations in the Field***

*Conversations in the Field* is a publication of papers arising from a peer-reviewed conference. Conference papers should be revised as necessary to prepare them for publication. Papers will be reviewed by the editor and will then receive one of the following designations: "Accepted", "Revisions Requested", or "Not Accepted for Publication."

Submissions should include an abstract of 100 words. The abstract should include the title and identity of the author. Papers should clearly and thoroughly follow either MLA or APA format. There is no minimum or maximum length. The journal is able to publish images, video, or audio.

The deadline for submission is October 31, 2011.
